Besides serving as ambassador to the United States in Washington from 1957-1961, Dr. Arnold was head of the Foreign Minister's office under Willy Brandt, as well as ambassador to the Netherlands, Italy and the United Nations in Geneva. His publications include *Germany's Power* (1995), *Europe to Be Thought Anew: Why and How to Further Unification?* (1999), *Security for Europe* (2002) and regular contributions in periodicals and newspapers. Arnold is a regular lecturer at the Academy for Political Science in Munich.
